Honor them through

Proverbs 22:6 ESV Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it.

2 Samuel 14:25 ESV Now in all Israel there was no one so much to be praised for his handsome appearance as Absalom. From the sole of his foot to the crown of his head there was no blemish in him. [26] And when he cut the hair of his head (for at the end of every year he used to cut it; when it was heavy on him, he cut it), he weighed the hair of his head, two hundred shekels by the king's weight. [27] There were born to Absalom three sons, and one daughter whose name was Tamar. She was a beautiful woman.

Honor them through

2 Samuel 14:23 ESV So Joab arose and went to Geshur and brought Absalom to Jerusalem. [24] And the king said, "Let him dwell apart in his own house; he is not to come into my presence." So Absalom lived apart in his own house and did not come into the king's presence.

2 Samuel 14:33 ESV Then Joab went to the king and told him, and he summoned Absalom. So he came to the king and bowed himself on his face to the ground before the king, and the king kissed Absalom.
