Matthew 21:14 ESV And the blind and the lame came to him in the temple, and he healed them.

Revelation 22:1 ESV Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life, bright as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb [2] through the middle of the street of the city; also, on either side of the river, the tree of life with its twelve kinds of fruit, yielding its fruit each month.
